1	Work cell common surfaces	Including control buttons, tools, and other common surfaces	Hospital grade disinfectant or fresh 10% chlorine bleach solution (sodium hypochlorite solution), as appropriate	Spray with hand held sprayer or wipe	Minimum at the end of each shift
2	Offices, desk, and conference rooms	Table and chair surface		Spray with hand held sprayer or wipe	Minimum at the end of each shift
3	Movable trays, containers, or Conveyor belts,	Wipe areas of common employee interphase		Spray with sprayer	Based on use; Once per shift if contacted by 1 person only; otherwise, between users
5	General objects often used or touched	Doors and windows, handles, faucets, sinks, and bathrooms		Spray with hand held sprayer or wipe	At least four times per day
6	Tableware	Disinfection of tableware		Place in high-temperature disinfection cabinet, with temperature higher than 60°C, and time longer than half an hour	After cleaning
7	Vending machines	Interface surfaces (pay, selection and vending surfaces)	Hospital grade disinfectant or fresh 10% chlorine bleach solution (sodium hypochlorite solution), as appropriate	Spray with sprayer	Daily
8	Vehicle or Forklifts	Wipe areas of common human interaction		Spray with sprayer	After each use
9	Multi-user safety vest and other PPE	All surfaces		Spray with sprayer	Between use
10	All floors and walls	All general floors and walls at site		Mop	Periodic, where frequently touched; mop hard surfaces daily
